PASSPORTS NEEDED

If you plan to take a quick trip by bridge or tunnel to Windsor, Canada, make sure that you are prepared. YOU MUST have a valid U.S. Passport. You can take the Ambassador Bridge, located at 3400 W. Fort Street, about two miles southwest of downtown Detroit. Cars are charged \$4 and buses must pay \$8.25.

You can take the Detroit-Windsor Tunnel at 100 East Jefferson Avenue. You'll pay a toll of \$4 and buses pay a toll of \$7.

The Detroit People Mover public transportation systems enables guests of the hotel to have easy access to all city attractions.
